



Someone gave Sophie oxycodone. Someone knew what was going on. And Hannah will not stop until she has uncovered the truth







Bedtime Boat by Sital Chapman 9780008534318 / Farshore / PB / R235






Monster Hunting 2 Monsters Bite Back by Ian Mark


When Minou's beloved Dima is murdered, she joins the secretive Green Orchids, rebels plotting to overthrow the General.



Can Ellie find a way out of the Underworld? And who - or what - will she be if she does?










The Horse Who Came Home by Olivia Tuffin 9781839946431 / Nosy Crow/ PB / R235




Bellegarde by Jamie Lilac 9780349125282 / Hodder / BPB / R250
