




Two Ants Puzzled! by Elizabeth Laird 9781910328477 / Thames and Hudson / PB / R310




Two Dogs by Ian Falconer 9780008561512 / HarperCollins / PB / R265


Will all return to normal before their owners come home?

With five colourful felt flaps and rich artwork from Axel Scheffler, toddlers will love Pip and Posy.










We Are the Smurfs: Bright New Days! by Peyo 9781419755415 / Abrams / HB / R345




TYGER by SF Said 9781788452915 / David Fickling / PB / R245

Can they learn to use their powers before it's too late?




Erik VS. Everything by Christina Uss 9780063290822 / HarperCollins/ PB / R225

Charmed Life (Wildseed Witch Book 2) by Marti Dumas 9781419755637 / Abrams / HB / R485



Not everyone will survive the night.










Scare Me by Teri Terry 9781444962727 / Hodder / PB / R220
